Our Reach

During the 23/24 school year, we collaborated with 44 schools and youth organizations spanning Arizona, Nevada, and New Mexico. Among these, 14 schools adopted our TeamUp Model, 8 implemented PairUp, and 22 benefited from our professional development and digital services. We maintained our longstanding partnerships with Creighton and Phoenix Elementary Districts, each exceeding 10 years. Additionally, we forged new partnerships, including with Arizona State University and the Boys and Girls Clubs of the Valley.


