



KINDERGARTEN KICKBALL

- 1. There are two teams: kickers and outfielders.**
- 2. The outfielders should spread out. Their goal is to get the kicked ball back to the pitcher as quickly as possible.**
- 3. There are no outs and no foul balls. The kickers line up and kick one at a time.**
- 4. The kicker runs along the baseline, picking up as many cones as possible before the ball is returned to the pitcher.**
- 5. Once the pitcher has the ball, he or she yells "STOP!" to the kicker, and the kicker stops running and collecting cones and returns to home base.**
- 6. The cones collected are placed back at home base in a pile.**
- 7. Kickers can run either direction on the baselines, but cannot run across the pitcher's mound.**
- 8. The inning is over once all kickers have kicked or if all the cones have been collected.**
